Drive up COVID-19 testing will be moving to the clinic parking lot effective Monday 6/1! The SAR greeting team will have their last day on campus 5/29. A huge thank you from Ferry County Health for their service!!!

Drive up COVID-19 testing is ongoing M-F 8am to 5pm (call the clinic @ 509-775-3153), for afterhours testing call 509-775-3333 option 1. Please drive up in front of the testing trailer and roll down all windows (a lane will be marked and someone will come soon to help you).

Our Hospital, Emergency Department, Clinic, Lab, and Radiology departments are open for routine care. We are beginning to do colonoscopies, EGD's and Ultrasound Guided Injections again (call 509-775-3153 for more info). Physical & Occupational Therapy is now open to face to face visits. Please call our rehab department for more details @ 509-775-8400. Behavioral Health appointments are now being offered in the clinic with Laura Karg, our licensed clinical social worker (call the clinic for more information or to schedule an appointment).

Please note for the safety of our community and staff, our visiting doctor area in the clinic is serving as an isolated respiratory clinic so our regular clinic can focus solely on non-COVID issues. Again, **our clinic, lab, emergency department, hospital, rehab department and radiology** are open and are working hard to provide safe options to accommodate our community! **We urge patients not to put off routine care. Life may be on pause but your healthcare should not be, don't become an emergency!**

Please note that for the safety of our Klondike Hills residents, Long Term Care residents, and staff visitors to Klondike Hills, our Hospital, and Long Term Care unit will continue to be limited (call ahead with questions). **As much as possible** when visiting our Emergency Department we ask only the person seeking treatment visit.
