

Ferry County Visitor Policy March 27, 2021

A restrictive visitation policy will be in place during this COVID 19 Pandemic. This policy can change at any time depending on the COVID activity in the community and this facility.

One Visitor may accompany the Patient during their appointment

Visitors and Patients will be screened and logged upon entering the facility for symptoms of respiratory illness as defined below (1). Only asymptomatic visitors will be allowed into normal clinical areas. Symptomatic visitors and Patients will be moved to Isolation rooms where they will have their office visit with the provider. Those who are unable or unwilling to wear an approved mask, even if no symptoms are reported, will also be moved to Isolation rooms.

If a patient or visitor is observed not wearing their mask in the normal clinical areas they will be asked to put a mask on and supplied with one if needed. If patient or visitor will still not wear a mask in the normal clinical areas they will be asked to leave.

¹ Symptoms: Fever or Chills, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, congestion or runny nose, vomiting or diarrhea.

Test positive for Covid -19 in the last 14 days or in contact with someone who has tested positive in the last 14 days.
